

2023 Wisconsin State Fair Camp of Champions Parent/Guardian Information

The Camp of Champions program was developed to give youth who participate in the Governor's Blue Ribbon Livestock Auction an educational, rewarding and fun opportunity to further enhance their livestock project experience during their extended stay at Wisconsin State Fair.

- Participants are required to stay in the Tommy G. Thompson (TGT) Youth Center and are required to remain at Wisconsin State Fair through Sunday, August 13th. Hardship exceptions will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis by the Camp of Champions committee. If hardship is granted, the exhibitor must be picked up from the Camp by a parent/legal guardian and signed out to the TGT Youth Center.
- The Camp of Champions exhibit is located in the southwest corner of the lower Cattle Barn.
- Hay, straw, and basic supplies will be provided. Camp participants may bring personal supplies. Show boxes are not allowed but will be provided for personal storage.
- Camp participants are required to work a minimum of two (2) 2 hour shifts per day. Participants are also expected to participate in service opportunities.
- Curfew for Camp of Champions exhibitors is 11:00 pm.
- Only Camp of Champion participants are allowed in the designated Camp of Champions rooms.
- Campers can leave after load out and clean up for the Camp of Champions area on Sunday, August 13th.
- A parent/guardian and exhibitor must attend the initial meeting on Thursday, August 10th at 4:30 pm. All forms must be signed, completed and submitted to the committee prior to leaving the exhibitor at the Camp.
- Parents are encouraged to join us for a luncheon on Sunday, August 13th. We will meet at the camp about 11:45 am to walk to the luncheon on the grounds.
- A parent/guardian must be present on Sunday, August 13th for the DNA sample collection, as a signature is required.
